- Finding resources/authentic documents to bring back to your home county, linked to the teaching of French/Spanish in your school.
- Further improving your competence and performance in French/Spanish
- Further developing your cultural awareness and understanding of contemporary France/Spain
- Further enhancing your understanding of each country's school system and language policies

At some point during the week **Training Session No4** will take place in the host school in the form of a formal meeting between host teacher/head teacher, participant and a member of the LFEE team to facilitate exchanges and communication and discuss sharing of good practice, common project and next steps.
