IMMERSION COURSE IN CANNES FOR PRIMARY TEACHERS

SAMPLE COURSE PROGRAMME

(All timings subject to changes. We will send you an updated course programme a few weeks before the start of your course.)

Day 1 Saturday Travelling Day

- Arrival of participants
- 17.30 First meeting with course tutors and presentation of the week. Tasks: discuss pre-course assignments given to participants; access PowerLanguage online course; get to know Cannes
- 19.30 **Dinner with the group**

Day 2 Sunday

- Breakfast
- 9h30-12h45 Classes
- 12.45-14.00 Lunch with the group at the Centre
- Afternoon **Walking guided tour of Cannes**, with specific activities to complete and integrate into a group project
- 19.30 **Dinner in a local restaurant** with the group

Day 3 Monday

- Breakfast
- 9.15-12.45 Classes (N.B. morning sessions from Monday to Friday all include a coffee break)
On days 3 to 5, morning sessions will be split into 2 ability levels
- Lunch with the group at the centre
- 14.00-15.45 Classes
- **Evening Join us for the trip to the cinema - Free dinner**

Day 4 Tuesday

- Breakfast
- 9.30-15h School visit (including lunch with French counterparts)
- **18.30 Debrief session with the group + dinner at the Centre**

Day 5 Wednesday

- 9.15-12h Classes
- **Boat trip** and excursion to the **Île Sainte-Marguerite** with specific activities to complete and integrate into a group project (+ lunch provided with the group)
- **Free dinner**

- Lunch with the group at the Centre
- Afternoon Finding information around Cannes to finish the group project
- 19.30 **Dinner at the centre** with the group

Day 7 Friday

- Lunch with the group at the Centre
- 14.00-15.45 Classes, including discussion, evaluation questionnaire and a few final games
- 19.00 **Certificates and celebration** at the centre with cocktails and finger food

- Use of songs in FL teaching
- Introduction to past tenses and practice
- Increasing fluency in French
- Exchanging ideas for activities
- Examples of good practice / Professional dialogue
- Group work
- Use of ICT in FL teaching
