Our **DIPS programmes** aim to equip school teachers, managers and coordinators of international projects with the essential tools to set-up their school international strategy and boost its international dimension, making sure these activities are sustainable. The courses provide participants with opportunities to enlarge their professional network, share good practice with colleagues and learn how to manage and implement lasting European projects.

Our DIPS programmes have been developed with support from the International team in the Académie of Montpellier (DAREIC) and is run by LFEE Europe in partnership with Interacting. DIPS takes place in various locations throughout Europe each year. **DIPS will be organised in Lisbon in 2021, with exact dates still to be confirmed.**

**New for 2020:** we have decided to run DIPS 1 and DIPS 2 as one programme this year in Brussels to prepare for the new Erasmus+ 2021 -2027 programme. We will be working with various institutions from the Belgian capital in order to find out more about the new programme and its new opportunities.
