This training course connects with the research and outputs of the Inscool2 Key Action 3 project. It includes a balance of formal presentations by education experts and participative workshops as well as a chance for participants to share good practice with colleagues and reflect on their own professional practices. Delegates will deepen their knowledge and understanding of inclusive education policy, practice and culture and enhance their skills for working inclusively in their own teaching environment. In addition, participants will reflect on how to enhance cooperation within the school community (parents, students, school staff) and with a wider spectrum of education stakeholders and how to address the diversity of learning needs. This course will increase the confidence and motivation of teachers to implement inclusive pedagogies.

## Organising Quality Pupil Mobilities within Erasmus+

At the heart of the Erasmus programme is the learning and enrichment which comes from travelling and hosting. Successful pupil mobilities can not only build lifelong friendships they can help sustain cultures of exchange which go beyond the expectations of specific projects. Our course is designed and delivered by experts in implementation and evaluation.



### Pupil mobility is a key element of

the school internationalisation process. Organising quality learning periods abroad within the framework of the Erasmus+ programme requires a detailed and precise execution of tasks in which all the agents involved intervene. In this course, we will establish methodologies to organise quality pupil mobilities in each school, in accordance with the quality standards of the Erasmus+ program, whether they are group mobilities or individual, short or long-term, mobilities.

### **Accommodation & Fee**

Our training venue is at the University of Galway, where participants' accommodation is in shared flats with individual en-suite rooms.

You will be staying in Dunlin Village, newly opened in 2023. It is comprised of bright, contemporary, apartments overlooking landscaped courtyards. Apartments contain 4-6 individual bedrooms along with a spacious shared kitchen and living area. Each bedroom has an en suite bathroom, ample storage, and a study desk. Also included is:

- \* On-site self-service launderette
- \* 24/7 support on site

### The fee for each of our 1-week courses is 1680€ and includes:

- \* Course and tuition fees
- \* Accommodation in individual en-suite rooms
- \* Meals: full board

Cultural activities in Galway are organised during the week. However, optional cultural excursions are not included.

Funding for all our courses is available through the Erasmus+ Programme. Places are allocated on a first come first served basis.

Interacting+ Ireland and LFEE Europe have been designing tailor-made teacher training courses in the UK, Ireland, Spain and around the world for more than 20 years. Since then, a growing community of teachers have brought activities and processes from their training to classroom practice. We have led on numerous projects of cooperation and innovation under the Erasmus+ KA2 and KA3 programmes.
