It is tailored for Vocational Education and Training (VET) professionals (including L5) across Europe and addresses the core aspects of a successful internationalisation strategy using the Erasmus+ programme. DIPS-VET runs alongside DIPS for School Education and provides a dynamic space for over 100 participants to learn, collaborate, and share best practices in the field of VET education. With a focus on themes relevant to Erasmus+ priorities, DIPS-VET offers a variety of learning experiences, from plenary sessions to workshops and peer-led exchanges. Participants can choose workshops suited to their specific needs and expertise levels.

At #DIPSVET25, our guiding theme will be:

Addressing the specific challenges to Internationalisation in VET Education

Inclusion, Health and Wellbeing in Education

This training course connects with the research and outputs of the Inscool2 Key Action 3 project. It includes a balance of formal presentations by education experts and participative workshops, as well as a chance for participants to share good practice with colleagues and reflect on their own professional practices.

Objectives of our "Inclusion, Health and Wellbeing in Education" training activity:

- To deepen knowledge and understanding of inclusive education policy, practice & culture
- To suggest ways to promote inclusive culture in the classroom
- To enhance the skills of teachers working inclusively in schools
- To understand and to address the diversity of learning needs in a classroom
- To give participants tools to work on collective problem sharing and solving
- To enhance cooperation within the school community (parents, students, school staff) and with a wider spectrum of education stakeholders











- To increase the confidence and motivation of teachers to implement inclusive pedagogies
- To explore principles of Inclusion, Health and Wellbeing within the host country's Education System
