This training course connects with the research and outputs of the **Inscool2 Key Action 3** project. It includes a balance of formal presentations by education **experts and participative workshops** as well as a chance for participants to share good practice with colleagues and reflect on their own professional practices. Delegates will deepen their knowledge and understanding of inclusive education policy, practice and culture and enhance their skills for working inclusively in their own teaching environment. In addition, participants will reflect on how to enhance cooperation within the school community (parents, students, school staff) and with a wider spectrum of education stakeholders and how to address the diversity of learning needs. **This course will increase the confidence and motivation of teachers to implement inclusive pedagogies.**

English Language and Culture Development



These courses offer just the right balance of **language skills development** and improving participants' expertise in the **pedagogy of language teaching**. You will be fully immersed in the English language and Irish culture, gaining enthusiasm and invaluable knowledge to take back to your target audience.

Learning and Teaching English through CLIL

4th-11th July 2026

This theme-based Language and Methodology course is specifically designed for primary and secondary teachers. **Participants are introduced to the principles of CLIL and explore how target languages and subjects can be taught together using creative approaches and games based activities.** The course is practical, engaging and aims to build a strong learning community. Some of our aims are:

- * To discover resources suitable for the **cross-curricular teaching** of English in schools
- * To refresh and enhance participant's **linguistic skills**
- * To **discover a different Education System** and the roles and responsibilities within it, from Government to educational establishments
- * To introduce **CLIL approaches** to Science and Maths, Arts and Drama, Outdoor Learning and PE.
- * During this course, the **focus will be on activities, resources and vocabulary** linked to these themes.



Venue

Accommodation & Fee

Our training venue is at the **University of Galway**, where participants' accommodation is in shared flats with individual en-suite rooms.

You will be staying in Dunlin Village, newly opened in 2023. It is comprised of bright, contemporary apartments overlooking landscaped courtyards. Apartments contain 4-6 individual bedrooms along with a spacious shared kitchen and living area. Each bedroom has an en suite bathroom, ample storage, and a study desk. Also included is:

- * Wi-Fi
- * On-site self-service launderette
- * 24/7 support on site

The fee for each of our 1-week courses is 1680€ and includes:

- * Course and tuition fees
- * Accommodation in individual en-suite rooms
- * Meals: full board

Cultural activities in Galway are organised during the week. However, the optional cultural excursions are not included in the fee.

Funding for all our courses is available through the Erasmus+ Programme. Places are allocated on a first come first served basis.
