# **English Language and Leadership in Education**

Location: Galway, Ireland

Duration: 6 days training / 8 days mobility

This course combines professional English language development with key themes in educational leadership. Participants will strengthen their English for professional communication while exploring leadership within teacher learning, the Irish education system, and successful approaches to teacher progression. Through cultural immersion, dialogue, and collaborative tasks, they will deepen their understanding of Ireland, and enhance their leadership communication skills.

# English Language and Leadership in Education course objectives:

- Strengthen participants' general and professional English through speaking, listening, reading and writing activities tailored to leadership and educational contexts.
- Build confidence in using English for leadership tasks such as presenting, chairing meetings, giving feedback, and engaging in professional dialogue.
- Deepen understanding of the Irish education system and explore key themes such as teacher development, progression, and successful leadership practices.
- Develop intercultural awareness of Ireland and the wider British Isles, linking language development with cultural insights relevant to school and system leadership.
- Promote professional reflection and exchange, enabling leaders to share challenges, compare practices, and develop new approaches for their institutions.
- Support the creation of international partnerships by enhancing communication skills, cultural competence, and knowledge of Erasmus+ opportunities.
